3. Legal and Ethical Framework

Legal Obligations

This policy is guided by global and U.S. standards, including:

- **Children Act 1989**
- **Children Act 2004**
- **United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (ratified 1991)**
- **Sexual Offences Act 2003**
- **Protection of Freedoms Act 2012**

Note: These UK laws serve as international benchmarks. U.S. and state-level child protection regulations, including those applicable in South Carolina and client jurisdictions, are also followed.

Ethical Standards

Dr. Constance Quigley, LLC adheres to a zero-tolerance policy for child abuse in any form. Our ethical framework is informed by the **Universal Declaration of Human Rights**, the **U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Child Welfare Guidelines**, and responsible safeguarding practices in digital and physical environments.

4. Definitions and Recognition of Child Abuse and Neglect

Types of Abuse

We recognize the following types of abuse and exploitation:

- **Physical Abuse:** Intentional infliction of physical harm or injury.
- **Emotional Abuse:** Repeated verbal or psychological mistreatment that damages emotional well-being.
- **Sexual Abuse:** Any form of sexual contact, coercion, or exposure involving a child.
- **Neglect:** Ongoing failure to provide necessary care, supervision, or emotional support.
- **Forced Child Labor:** Assigning or expecting work that places the child's academic, physical, or emotional development at risk.

5. Reporting and Response Protocols

All concerns, reports, or disclosures of suspected abuse or misconduct must be directed immediately to Dr. Constance Quigley or a designated safeguarding contact. Confidentiality will be honored to the fullest extent allowable by law.

Anonymous reporting is allowed, and we take every report seriously.

6. Training and Awareness

All staff, partners, and volunteers working with or near minors will be oriented on this policy. Ongoing awareness and training materials may be distributed as needed to ensure all participants understand appropriate boundaries, communication, and reporting obligations.
